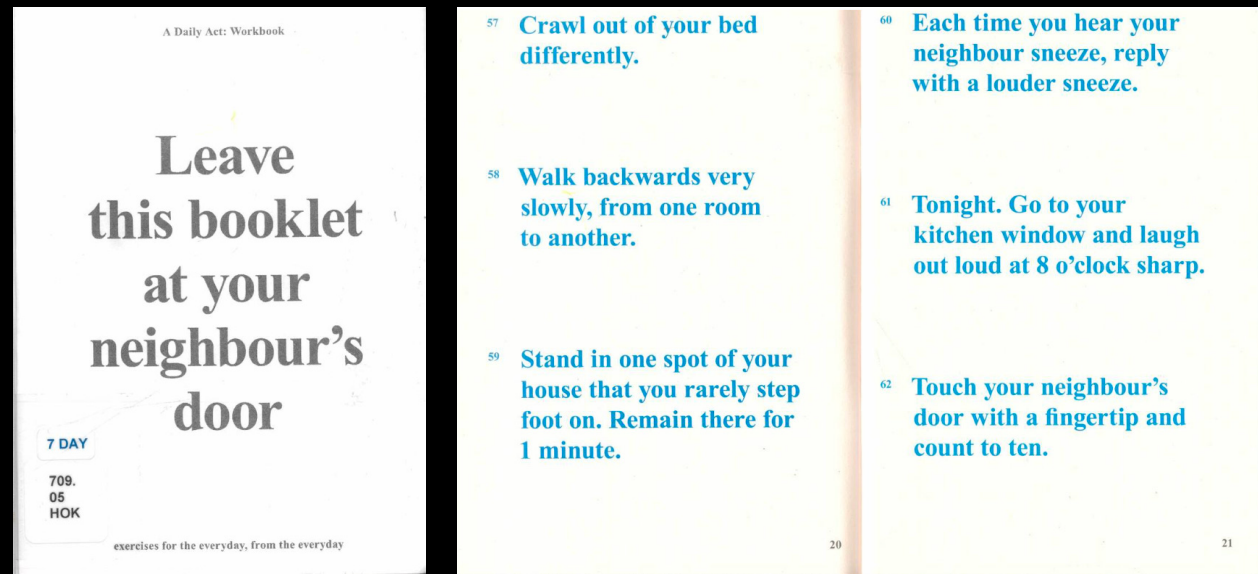


Arrow logic breakdown

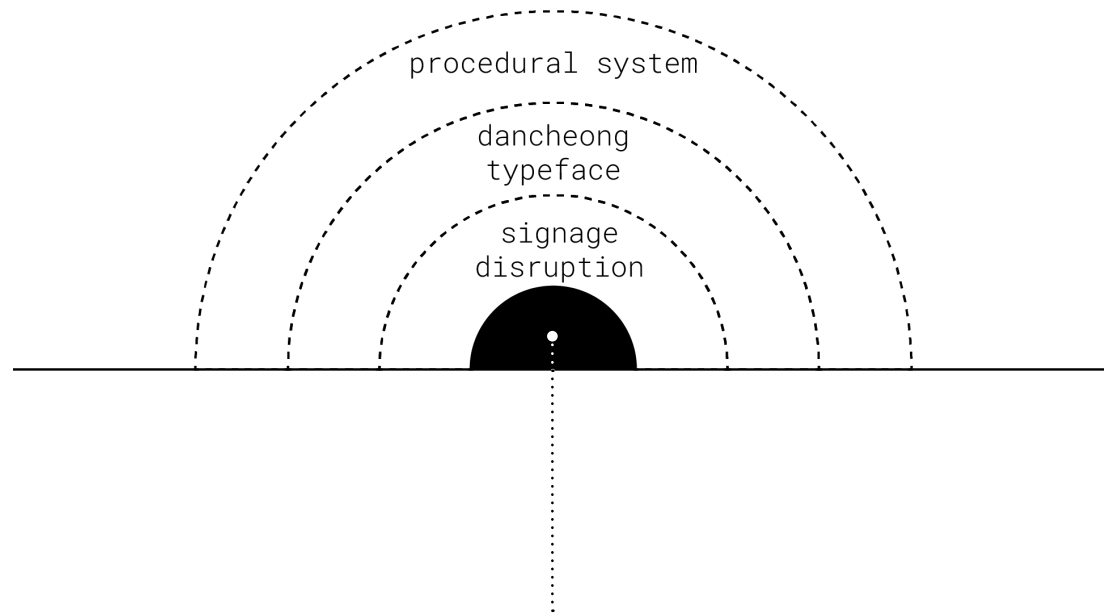
